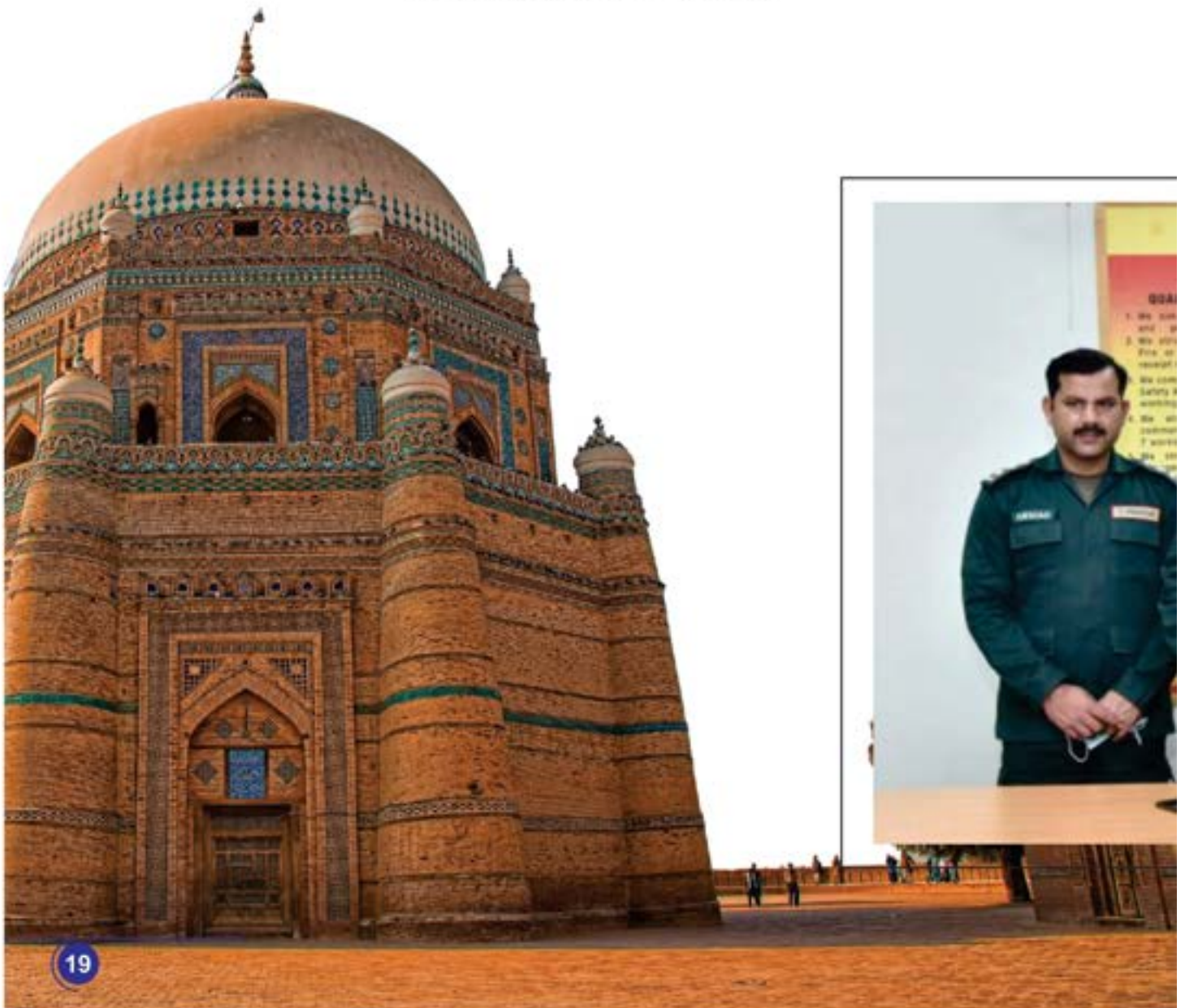

# A Meeting on Revamping Matriculation



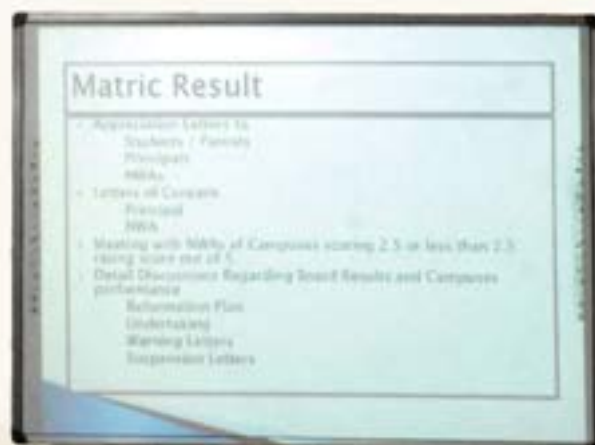

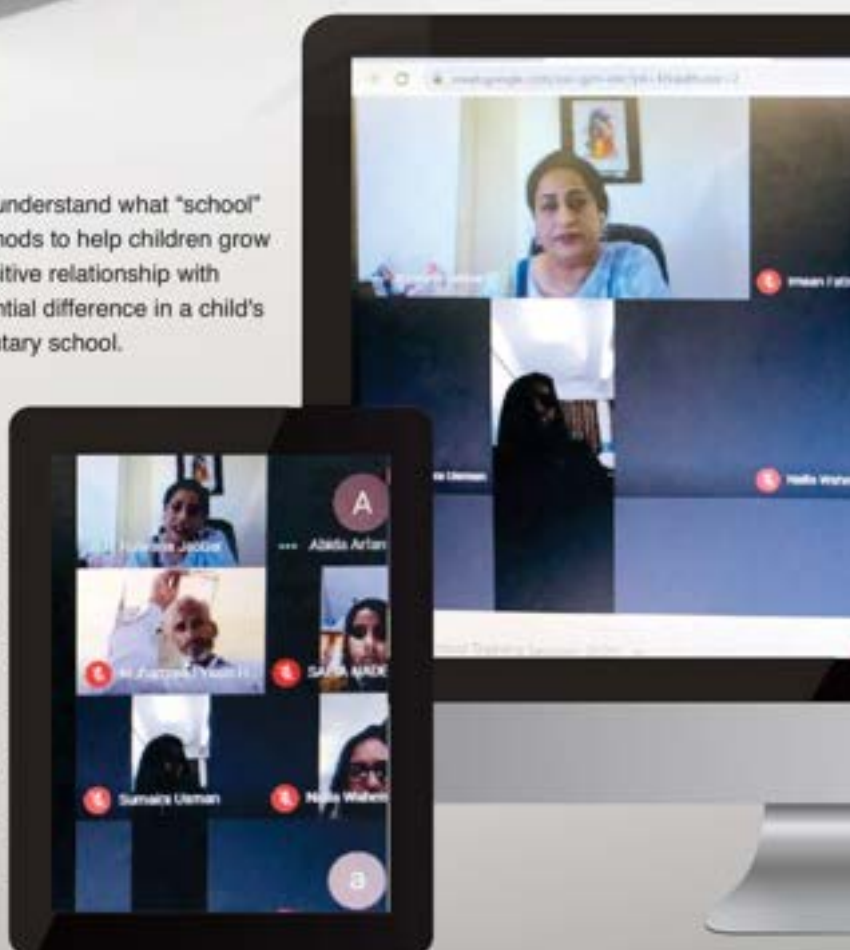


# Preschool Online Training Sessions

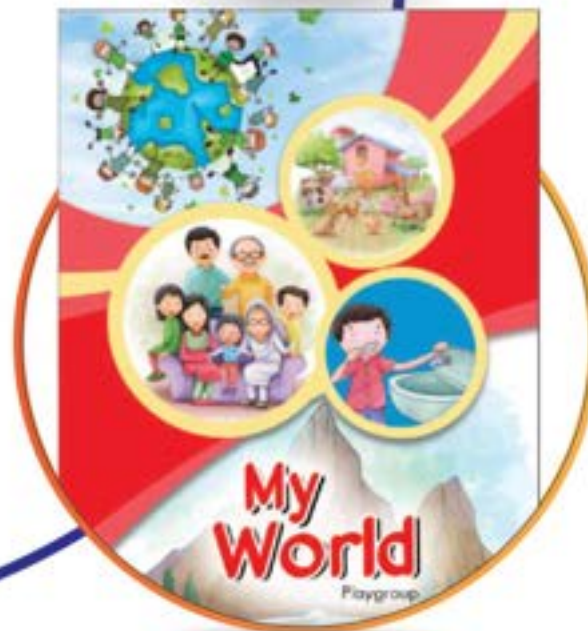




# NEW SYLLABUS of PRESCHOOL as per SNC (SINGLE NATIONAL CURRICULUM) 2020

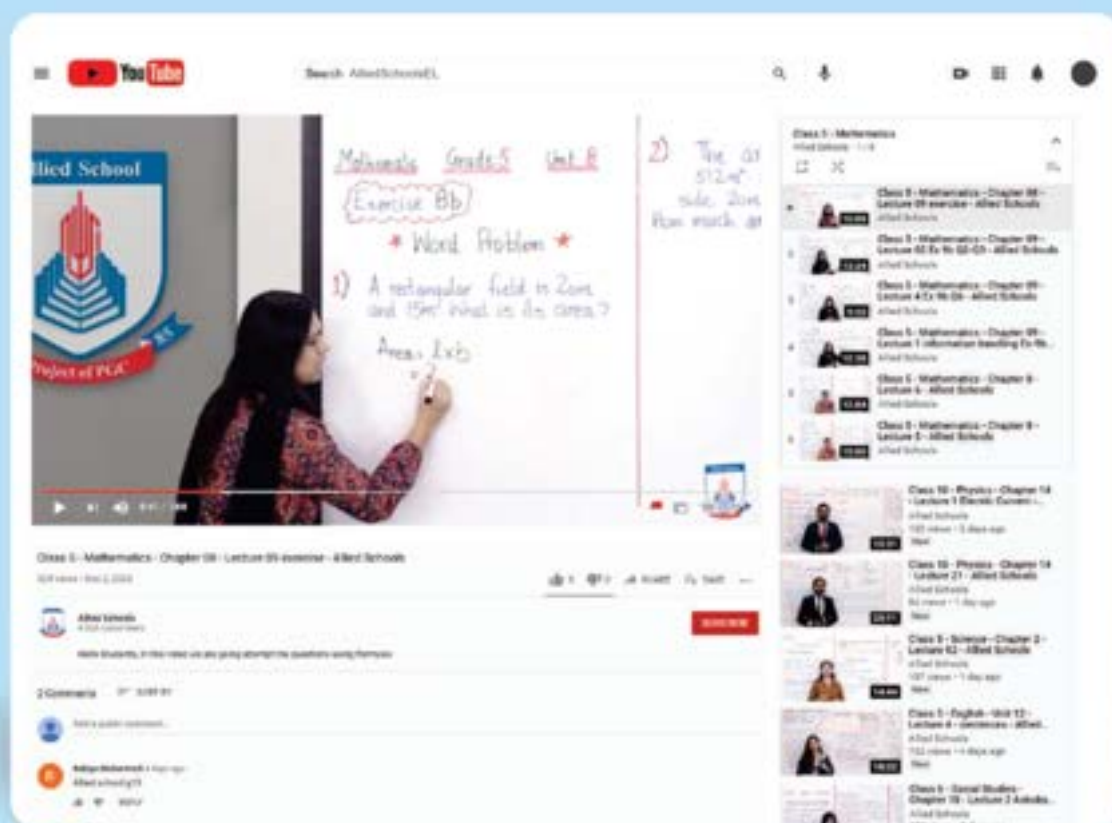

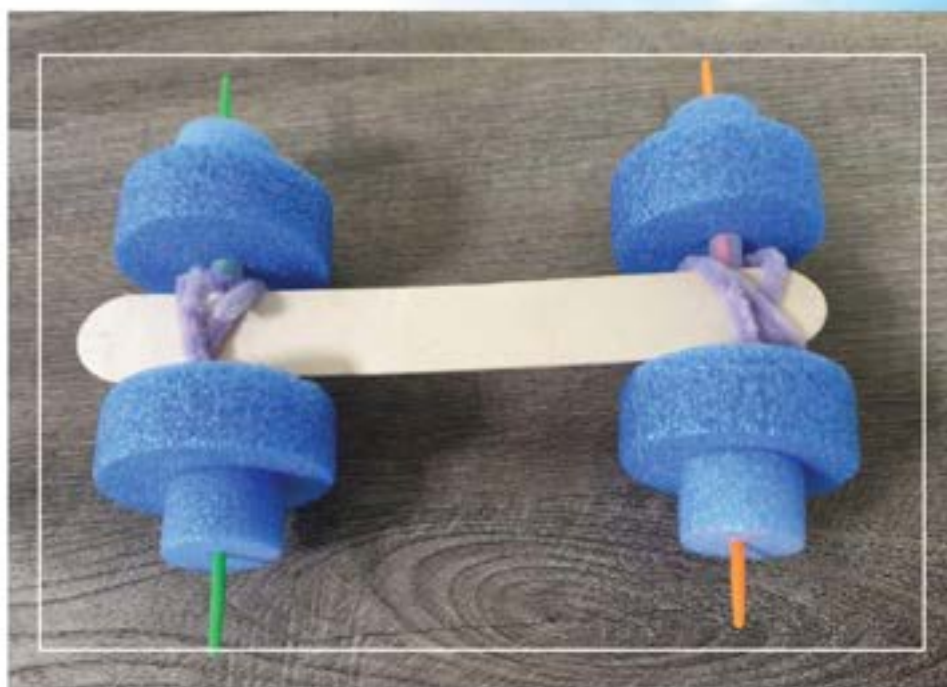
